These are the responsibilities drafted for a "DCNA Area Monitor".

Immediate Activities (Blue Sky)

- I. Meet with Co-Captains and other DCNA Area Monitors in January 2015 to discuss and coordinate neighborhood profile updating.
- 2. Complete CERT Census Sheets (provided) for the homes in your area.
- 3. Complete CERT Equipment Inventory (provided) for the homes in your area.
- 4. Determine and record if any special needs or attention needs be given in the event of a disaster.
- 5. Conduct Q&A with your area neighbors regarding neighborhood preparedness.
- 6. Distribute placards and information to each household in your area.
- 7. Return the documents resulting from your area survey to the Co-Captains.

Activities in the event of a disaster (Grey Sky)

- I. Make an immediate quick damage/needs assessment of your area. Promptly report status to Central Command.
- 2. Immediately report any urgent needs (medical, first aid, search and rescue, shelter or child care) to the Incident Commander at Central Command.

Quarterly Activities (Blue Sky)

1. Update any changes since previous profile were submitted.

Annual Activities (Blue Sky)

1. Meet as a group with co-Captains of DCNA Emergency Preparedness and other Area Monitors.
