# COMMUNICATIONS STATION

(last updated Tuesday, September 01, 2015)

These are the responsibilities drafted for a "DCNA COMMUNICATIONS STATION".

# Immediate Activities (Blue Sky)

- I. Prepares a communications facility (typically a HAM radio transmitting/receiving station) for DCNA neighbors.
- 2. Possesses and Maintains required radio license and familiarity with El Cerrito City Hall communications.
- 3. Prepares forfacilitating DCNA communications in the event of a catastrophic event.

# Activities in the event of a disaster (Grey Sky)

- I. Relays messages to and from Command Post and Teams in the field via messengers (runners) or CB or HAM radios.
- 2. Relays messages to and from Command Post and First Aid Stations and Shelter Sites.
- 3. Relays messages to and from Command Post and City of El Cerrito Emergency Communications Center.

### **Quarterly Activities (Blue Sky)**

- I. Maintains constant connection with local radio operators and City of El Cerrito network.
- 2. Checks on activities of adjoining neighborhood (Kensington, Richmond, Berkeley) communications networks.

### Annual Activities (Blue Sky)

I. Meet as a group with co-Captains of DCNA Emergency Preparedness and DCNA Area Monitors.
