FIRST AID STATION

(last updated Tuesday, September 01, 2015)

These are the responsibilities drafted for a "DCNA FIRST AID STATION".

Immediate Activities (Blue Sky)

- I. Prepares a space to sets up a local First Aid Station for DCNA neighbors.
- 2. Receives and stores a bag of First Aid supplies, bandages and reference handbooks.
- 3. Prepares for taking in hurt or traumatized neighbors in the event of a catastrophic event.

Activities in the event of a disaster (Grey Sky)

- I. Sets up a Local First Aid Station and operates it for DCNA neighbors.
- 2. Performs triage, treats injuries, gives comfort.
- 3. Documents patient inventory, extent of injuries and actions taken.
- 4. Informs Command Post of patients needing immediate hospitalization.

Quarterly Activities (Blue Sky)

I. Reviews stored supplies to be sure they are in good condition and not out-dated.

Annual Activities (Blue Sky)

I. Meet as a group with co-Captains of DCNA Emergency Preparedness and DCNA Area Monitors.
