FIRST AID STATION

(last updated Tuesday, September 01, 2015)

These are the responsibilities drafted for a “DCNA FIRST AID STATION”.

Immediate Activities (Blue Sky)

1. Prepares a space to sets up a local First Aid Station for DCNA neighbors.
2. Receives and stores a bag of First Aid supplies, bandages and reference handbooks.
3. Prepares for taking in hurt or traumatized neighbors in the event of a catastrophic event.

Activities in the event of a disaster (Grey Sky)

1. Sets up a Local First Aid Station and operates it for DCNA neighbors.
2. Performs triage, treats injuries, gives comfort.
3. Documents patient inventory, extent of injuries and actions taken.
4. Informs Command Post of patients needing immediate hospitalization.

Quarterly Activities (Blue Sky)

1. Reviews stored supplies to be sure they are in good condition and not out-dated.

Annual Activities (Blue Sky)

1. Meet as a group with co-Captains of DCNA Emergency Preparedness and DCNA Area Monitors.
