PET SHELTERING SITE SUPERVISOR

These are the responsibilities drafted for a "DCNA PET SHELTERING SITE SUPERVISOR".

Immediate Activities (Blue Sky)

- I. Familiarizes self (and backup, if possible) with location of DCNA PET SHELTERING SITE.
- 2. Seeks spare supplies of food, bowls and crates for pets in the neighborhood.
- 3. Familiarizes self with neighborhood pets.

Activities in the event of a disaster (Grey Sky)

- I. When possible, reports to DCNA PET SHELTERING SITE.
- 2. Receives incoming pets and provides calm reassurance.
- 3. Provides animals with water and comfort.
- 4. Makes sure animals are fed at suppertime.
- 5. Confines troublesome animals in their crates or cages, still providing them with foot and water.

Quarterly Activities (Blue Sky)

- I. Helps assemble food and supplies to provide care for animals brought to DCNA PET SHELTERING SITE.
- 2. Refreshes procedures and document methods with team members.

Annual Activities (Blue Sky)

I. Meet as a group with co-Captains of DCNA Emergency Preparedness and DCNA Area Monitors.
