SAFETY AND SECURITY TEAM

(last updated Tuesday, September 01, 2015)

These are the responsibilities drafted for a "DCNA SAFETY AND SECURITY TEAM".

Immediate Activities (Blue Sky)

- I. Familiarizes self with shut-off procedures for Power, Gas and Water.
- 2. Prepares for calling and deploying Damage Assessment Teams (no fewer than two persons per team) for DCNA neighborhood in the event of a catastrophic event.

Activities in the event of a disaster (Grey Sky)

- I. Deploys teams (no fewer than two) to deal with immediate Safety and Security issues, or to neighbors as directed by the Command PostShuts off utilities, if needed, on a house-by-house basis (gas, electricity, water).
- 2. Removes broken glass and other debris.
- 3. Ropes off hazard areas.
- 4. Extinguishes minor fires.
- 5. Rounds up loose pets and transports them to Pet Shelter Site.
- 6. Documents and reports to Command Post all incidents and actions.

Quarterly Activities (Blue Sky)

- 1. Helps assemble needed equipment and supplies to perform required assignment (procedures, reporting documents, tapes and signs, fire extinguishers, etc.)
- 2. Refreshes procedures and document methods with team members.

Annual Activities (Blue Sky)

I. Meet as a group with co-Captains of DCNA Emergency Preparedness and DCNA Area Monitors.
